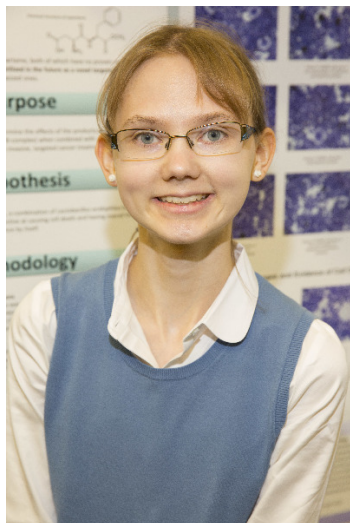

Evaluating Therapeutic Potential of Lactobacillus and Aspartame on Cancer Cells

Challenge: Health

Abstract: This experiment tested the effects of Lactobacillus acidophilus bacteria and aspartame on cervical and kidney cancer cells. A combination of Lactobacillus bacterial products and a low concentration of aspartame was more effective at causing cell death than either product by itself; possibly opening up a new area of targeted cancer therapy with reduced side effects.
