Abstract: The focus of this year long study of the Carcinus maenas was to investigate

the correlation between time of year and the Gonadosomatic Index
Percentage of the Green Crab and to determine whether abiotic factors
(air/water temperature, salinity) affect the abundance of the Green Crab.
Additional investigation was conducted to determine the possibility of Green

crab as potential organic compost to alleviate this existing problem.
