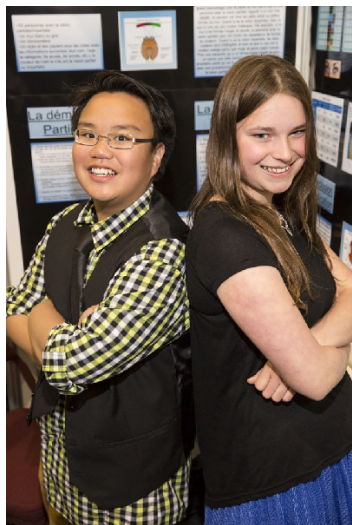


# CWSF 2015 - Fredericton, New Brunswick
