

Concentrating on Neonicotinoids

Challenge: Environment

Abstract: Scientists debate the role of neonicotinoids in the population decline of

pollinators. This project examined the effects of five concentrations of neonicotinoids on Drosophila and related the results to pollinators. The thirty-three trials conducted for this investigation showed that as the concentration of neonicotinoid increased, the success rates of Drosophilas' food seeking behaviour were consistently less than 75%, clearly confirming

the impairment of the specimens.

Biography

My name is Megan Thomson. I am a grade 12 student at Bruce Peninsula District School in Lion's Head, Ontario.
