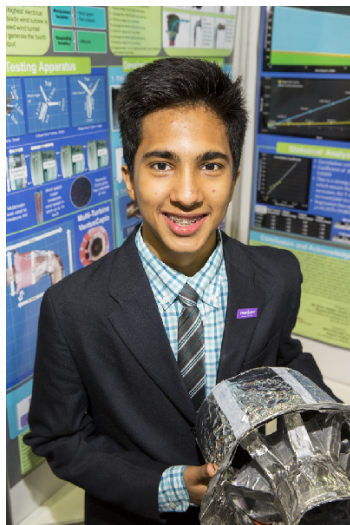

Abstract: Wind turbines are promising; however, they are burdened with flaws. I have designed a novel wind energy harnessing mechanism that causes close to zero avian mortalities; in contrast, approximately one million avian mortalities are caused by the current turbines. My invention produces approximately five times the electrical output of the classic wind turbine in virtually all wind speeds while maintaining the net area.

Biography

I am currently 15 years old, and I attend Ecole McTavish, which is located in Fort McMurray, Alberta. I am the design leader of the Infinity Robotics Team; we have recently won the provincial tournament, and now we are proceeding to the international championship. I also enjoy playing multiple sports; however, I particularly excel at volleyball, and more so soccer. I played for my school's volleyball team, and we won gold at the regional tournament.
