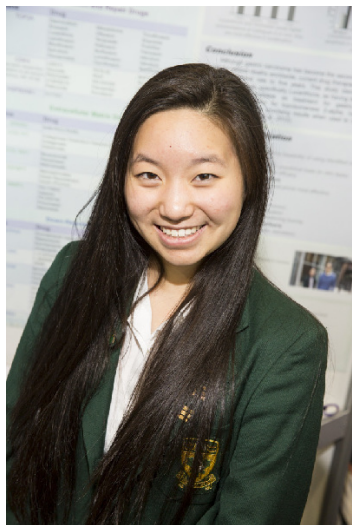

Isolating Genes for Gastric Carcinoma Treatment via Expression Meta-Analysis

Abstract: Gastric carcinoma is the second leading cause of cancer-related deaths worldwide; however, the current rate of drug therapy efficacy for existing treatments is less than 20%. A meta-analysis was done to analyze 226 genes to determine whether their expression and pathways influence the development of gastric cancer. Topoisomerase 2-alpha has been identified as the most promising target of inhibition, with Lucanthone as a possible inhibitor.

Biography

Elizabeth Suen is a Grade 11 student at York House in Vancouver, BC, where she has maintained an "Honours with Distinction" standing. Being a well-rounded individual, Elizabeth's plethora of interests include music, sports, and community involvement. As a result, her current project explores an area new to Elizabeth--the field of bioinformatics--as a means of uncovering alternative treatments to combat this carcinoma.
