Abstract:	How clean are our local

Abstract: How clean are our local water sites? I have tested nine local water sites in the Elk Valley for bacteria/coliforms and e.coli. My hypothesis is that if I tested a man-made lake and a duckpond for bacteria, they would have higher levels of bacteria than any of the other water sources I tested. My hypothesis was 50% correct.
