Chemotherapy in a Nutshell

Abstract: We studied the ability of naturally derived compounds to induce cell death on colorectal cancer cells. The anti-carcinogenic properties of our natural compounds were compared to Taxol's ability to induce cell death on the HCT-8 cell. We also tested the differentiation properties of the natural compounds in order to determine the compatibility between exosomal delivery and the use of naturally derived drugs in chemotherapy treatment.
