Abstract: Turmeric, a spice well known for its medicinal properties was tested against Amoxicillin for its antibacterial effects. Dosages of 2500 and 5000 mg were tested against Amoxicillin 500 mg on Streptococcus Mutans. Results showed 5000 mg of turmeric had comparable effects to 500 mg amoxicillin. This experiment has shown great promise for future treatment of streptococcal related infections with turmeric.
