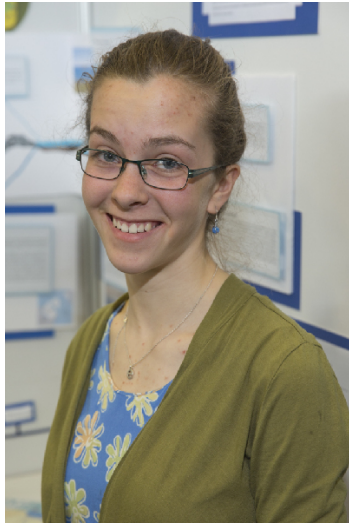


## CWSF 2016 - Montreal, Quebec
