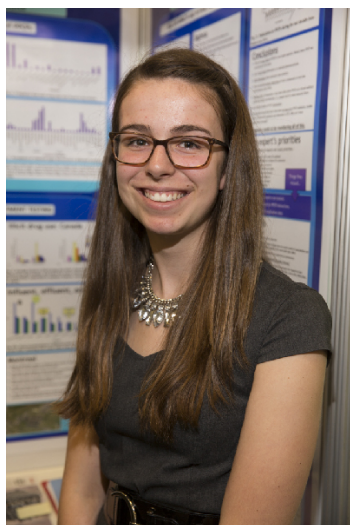

Filthy Water Cannot Be Washed: Pharmaceuticals and Personal Care Products

Challenge: Environment

Abstract: I reviewed the evidence of pollution from pharmaceuticals and personal care products (PPCPs). I looked at which PPCPs were in water systems, how they were getting there, if their levels were increasing, and what information was being collected. I found evidence that medications and other products negatively impact animals and children, and that some have additive effects. There is no coordinated, long-term tracking of PPCPs.
