Abstract: The prevalence of prescription medications in North American bodies of water are rapidly contributing to the deterioration of the environment. To discern the effect of prevalent medications on plant life, Metformin and Crestor were introduced to fenugreek seeds at different concentrations. Uncontaminated, bottled water was used as a control and the effects of the medications were observed over 15 days.
