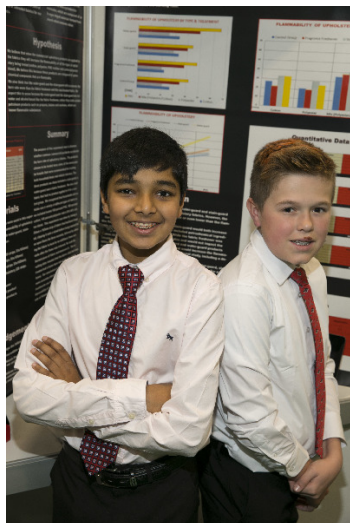

Learn The Burn

Challenge: Discovery

Abstract: We tested three different types of consumer products (water-guard, stain-guard and fabric freshener) by exposing four types of fabrics to an open flame and measuring the resulting burn to determine whether they had an impact on flammability. We concluded that water-guard and stain-guard increased the overall flammability of all upholstery fabrics which could increase the risk of injury or even death in a fire.
