One Step at a Time

Challenge: Innovation

Abstract: The purpose of the innovation is to describe the impact of an app designed to reduce participants' carbon footprint (CF) using the principle of crowdsourcing. Forty-one students calculated their personal CF score and downloaded the app. Participants were followed for one week using the app and recalculated their CF. The control group reduced their CF by 0.5 tonnes more than the experimental group, rejecting the hypothesis ($p < 0.05$).
