Sitting or Standing? Does It Really Matter?

Abstract: In this study, I examined the effects of standing on students' general

intelligence task performance. I tested each child using 2 general intelligence tests of the same level with a 10-minute limit, both while standing and sitting. The results of the data collected showed that there is no significant difference between students' sitting and standing scores.
