




## ESPC 2018 - Ottawa (Ontario)



## Biographie

ommaire: The study explores the potential of cranberry flavonoids in cancer chemotherapy through the efficacy of combination testing with anticancer drugs. Current understanding of flavonoid drug interactions and mechanisms is limited, so this study aimed to tackle these problems. Candidate drug combinations with cranberry extract and the effects of drug resistance on these combinations were identified, while mechanisms of action were proposed for future study.
