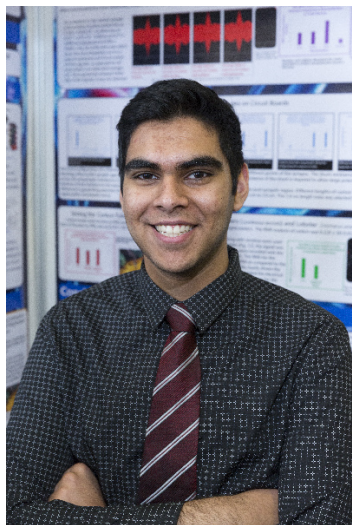

A Novel Approach to Restore Connectivity in Spinal Nerve Systems

Abstract: This project involves designing a neural device that restores connectivity in damaged spinal nerve systems. The device uses carbon acting as an electrical stimulant and nicotine/cafeine/glutamate acting as a chemical stimulant to keep the signals transmitting in their pathways. A variety of experiments have been conducted to study the nerve conduction in electrical circuit boards, and nerves in biological systems.
