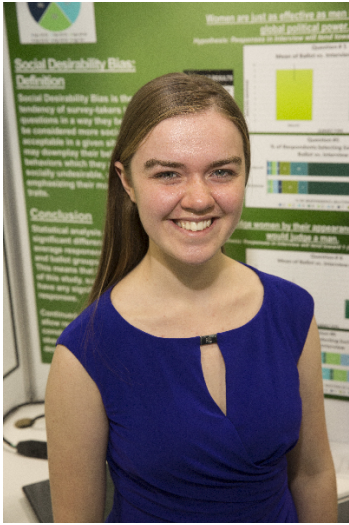

Abstract: Can a person give an honest statement of their controversial beliefs when they feel like they might be judged or accountable to those beliefs? 250 people were given the same survey asking for their opinions on controversial statements regarding gender roles. Half were given the survey by an anonymous ballot, half were given a face-to-face interview survey, and the answers were compared using statistical analysis.
