Brushing Away the Competition

Abstract: This project used eggs submerged in a staining liquid to determine toothpaste performance in two categories; prevention and whitening. Eight different toothpastes were tested including a homemade version. Tests were conducted by placing toothpaste onto the egg prior to submersion for protection and by scrubbing with toothpaste on a previously stained egg for whitening. Tests were conducted across four different staining agents.
