




CWSF 2019 - Fredericton, New Brunswick

their tentacles, used to inject venom into prey (Picture an injection that you
received at a doctors office, shrunk by 5000x). I used these extraordinary
cells to develop a simpler, inexpensive, and less laborious gene-delivery
device, capable of injecting DNA into a variety of stem cells in a less
invasive manner than current technologies.
