Challenge: Innovation

Abstract: We tried to make a stove that burned faster / more cleanly than a wood fire by adding a fan to increase air flow and spiral the flame. We added a thermoelectric generator to make electrical power to run the fan, so that the stove can power itself. Our innovation reduces soot and allows for faster heating, reducing the user's exposure to harmful emissions.
