Abstract: Dinitrobenzene Sulphonic Acid (DNB) and Dextran Sulphate Sodium (DSS) treated mucosa displayed Ulcerative Colitis and Crohn's Disease respectively. DNB, DSS, and normal mucosa were scored for architectural change and cellular disposition. Histological features were tallied, averaged, and charted. This chart will aid practitioners to diagnose Ulcerative Colitis and Crohn's Disease.
