Abstract: Body by Influence was a study that was used to discover if the mass media

negatively affected the body image of girls and young women ages 12 to 18. Girls were found to have an 11% lower body image after viewing thin body images than girls who viewed normal body images. Observing thin body image images decreased the performance of young women.
