Abstract: This project tested boil/bite mouthguards versus custom fitted mouthguards

to determine which mouthguard provided better protection against dental trauma. Indirect and direct blows were simulated on dental models using home designed equipment. The custom fitted mouthguard was found to have superior protection during a indirect blow while both mouthguards

were found to have similar protection during a direct blow.
