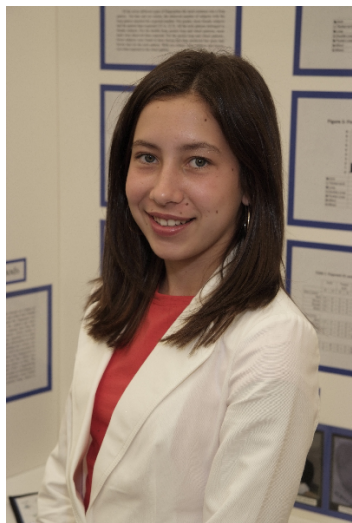

#### Association Between Fingerprint Pattern and Hair Colour, Eye Colour and Gender

**Abstract:** The thumbprints of thirty-eight unrelated individuals were obtained and classified into one of seven fingerprint patterns. Hair and eye colour and gender were recorded in each case. From this small study, some fingerprint patterns have a stronger association with hair colour, eye colour and gender than expected. Further studies are needed with larger populations to see if these findings hold true.

#### Biography
