## Left? or Right? - Lateral Dominance in Cats

Abstract: Lateral dominance was tested in 100+ housecats. A statistically significant

(95% level or higher) pattern of preference was found with female cats showing preference for the left side when compared to male cats. Paw preference was tested over two years (2007/2008) with male cats showing significant (95% level or higher) right paw preference and female cats

showing significant left paw preference during problem solving.
