**Abstract:** This experiment measured divergent thinking (which is one component of creativity) using Guilford's multiple uses test, and compared scores from grades two to eight. The summation score as described by Runco (the sum of the fluidity, originality and flexibility scores) was employed. It showed that as the level of education increased, the scores decreased.
