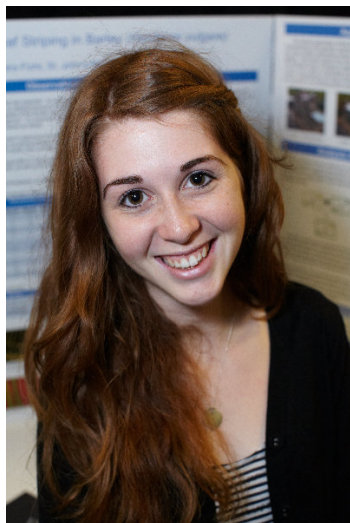

A Study of the Leaf Striping in Barley

Abstract: This project aimed to determine whether the variegated leaf striping in barley is controlled by the cytoplasmic genome, nuclear genome or both. Further investigations were made regarding the number of chloroplasts in normal vs. defective leaves to identify the difference in energy production via photosynthesis.

My name is Alexandra Ficht and I am a grade 12 student at St. John's Kilmarnock School. I have participated in science fair at my local school since I was in grade 5; however, this is my first CWSF.
