

Abstract: This project, engaging high school students using social engineering, is designed to help secondary school students get more involved in extra-curricular activities by utilizing the technology they carry every day. Using programming languages Swift, PHP and MySQL, the phone application is designed to generate personalized results identifying which clubs, groups and activities that they should join and will match them with students sharing common interests.
