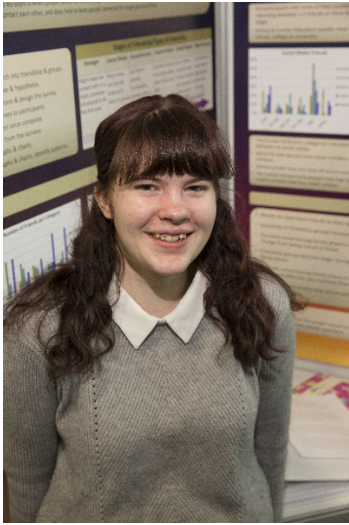

Abstract: This project investigates how friendship changes over time. Sample groups across multiple age categories were asked questions about numbers of friends and types of friendships over their lifetime. The results indicate at what life stage people stop accumulating new friends and when friendships become more meaningful to them and the role that social media plays in how friendships are formed.
