Which Mouthwash Best Reduces Oral Bacteria?

Abstract: In this study, I examined the effectiveness of mouthwash on reducing bacteria. I examined five mouthwash solutions, city water, saliva and isopropyl alcohol. The solutions were saturated on filter paper, placed in a petri dish with a sample of bacteria and incubated. The zone of inhibition was measured. The results show that a higher alcohol solution results in a greater zone of inhibition.
