Abstract: The purpose of this project was to determine if the fumes of pungent spices could kill bacteria in and from sports equipment. Phase 1 tested fumes contained in a petri dish, phase 2 tested fumes in running shoes and phase 3 tested for preventative effect on insoles. Wasabi, mustard and cayenne fumes killed bacteria effectively in all three phases.
