Abstract: MCF 7 cells were cultured and treated with multiple doses of Paclitaxel. Also added were Flax Seed, Vitamins C and Vitamin E. At 8 X 10⁻⁹ M, 2 X 10⁻⁷ M & 10⁻⁶ M doses of Taxol with Flax Seed, results showed a statistical difference in comparison to a treatment of Taxol.
